2nd Annual Escondido Figure Skating Club Spring Performance Competitive, Artistic & Exhibition Programs

The Escondido Figure Skating Club invites you to the 2nd Annual Spring Performance to be held at Escondido Iceoplex, located at 555 North Tulip St., Escondido, California. The arena ice surface measures 100' X 200' with slightly rounded corners.

The event will be open to all U.S. Figure Skating Members, students of Escondido Figure Skating Club Home-Club Coaches and any other Ice-O-Plex Escondido Figure Skating School Students. The 2nd Annual Escondido Figure Skating Club Spring Performance will be conducted in accordance with the U.S. Figure Skating 2010 Rulebook except as noted in this Announcement. Official notices and bulletins will be posted on the official bulletin board at the Ice-O-Plex Escondido arena and on the Escondido Figure Skating Club website www.Escondidofsc.org

The purpose of this event is four-fold:

1. To provide competitive U.S. Figure Skating skaters, students of Escondido Figure Skating Club Home Member Coaches, as well as Ice-O-Plex Skating School Students an opportunity to skate their competitive program(s) prior to the greater San Diego area's first competition for the 2010 skating season.
2. To provide U.S. Figure Skating skaters the opportunity to have their competitive program(s) critiqued by judges if the skater so desires.
3. To provide Ice-O-Plex Skating School Students not yet members of U.S. Figure Skating the opportunity not only to perform their own competitive programs before an audience but also to acquaint them to the world of U.S. Figure Skating and to view the programs of a wide range of U.S. Figure Skating members.
4. To provide family and friends of participating skaters an opportunity to watch their skater's program(s).

It must be pointed out that the EFSC Spring Performance, unlike a competition, does not require skaters to perform a "finished product" program. Rather, this event is being specifically timed to occur prior to the competition season so that no-matter at what stage of development a skater's program(s) is/are, that the skater has an opportunity to perform their program(s) and the opportunity for a critique, if desired. In fact, it could be argued that the Spring Performance will be of the most benefit to skaters whose programs are not yet finished and who wish to obtain a judge's opinion prior to doing so. Competitive, Artistic and Exhibition Programs are all welcome for this event.

ENTRY DEADLINE IS February 15, 2010

All entries MUST BE ***RECEIVED*** (not postmarked) by the Registrar NO LATER than midnight, February 15, 2010. Entries received after this date may be accepted at the discretion of the Chief Referee and **ONLY** if accompanied by a **\$10.00 late fee, but no entries will be accepted later than midnight, February 22, 2010**. All entries must be completely filled out and signed by the skater (parent, if the skater is under the age of 18). Incomplete entries will be returned, to be completed by the closing date for entries.
